**Re: Geography Field Work and UK University and Apprenticeship Search Fair –
Wednesday 25th – Friday 27th September**

We are now in the final stages of planning the trip for the joint Careers and Geography trip. Six students from year 12 and 13, who study A level Geography will be out of school from Wednesday 25th September until Friday 27th September. Those students who do not study A level Geography, will be out of school Thursday 26th September until Friday 27th September.

On **Wednesday 25th September, A Level Geography students will leave school at 8am** and travel to the Holderness Coast to look at erosional features and management strategies, including visiting Flamborough Head to look at geology. They will then travel to Hull for dinner and the accommodation for the evening.

Geography students, will be accompanied by Mr Mitchell and Mrs Gannon. On Wednesday evening students will be staying on the outskirts of Hull. Due to the extra day required for the field work, there is an additional cost for those studying Geography, of £46 for the accommodation. This payment can be made using ParentPay, with the deadline being 23rd September 2024.

On Thursday 27th September, Geography students will travel to Manchester, to tour sites across the city and explore the regeneration that has taken place.

Those students who do not study A level Geography will depart school at **9am on Thursday 26th September**, travelling to Manchester by bus. We aim to arrive in Manchester around 11am, where we will drop luggage at the hotel and then head into the city centre for some lunch and free time for the students, meeting up with the A level Geography students.

We will spend the evening taking part in an activity and having some dinner; students will be fully consulted on the evenings' plans next week before a booking is made. Breakfast for Friday morning is included £40 payment that has already been made.

On Friday 27th September we will be attending the UK University and Apprenticeship Search Fair at Old Trafford. The fair will feature a wide range of vital **seminars** including: UCAS Personal Statement & Application Advice, why take an Apprenticeship, Choosing a University Course, Higher and Degree Apprenticeships and Student Finance. The event is perfectly timed to help students in Year 13 as they prepare their UCAS and apprenticeship applications. It is also ideal for Year 12s, who are starting to make decisions about their post-18 education and career choices.
