## Cost

Due to the costs associated with running the enrichment programme, we kindly request a voluntary contribution of £15 from each student participating. This contribution helps us continue to work with external providers and supply resources for in-school activities, ensuring all students benefit from a high-quality experience every Wednesday afternoon.

The voluntary contribution will appear as a payment item on ParentPay, with a deadline of 31st October 2026. This is a one-off payment covering the full 2026/27 academic year.

Please note that, due to the nature of some activities, there may be additional requests for voluntary contributions—for example, for off-site visits or activities led by external instructors. Any such contributions will be communicated by the activity leader via the school email system



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# Enrichment Activities

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Students will be allocated up to six different activities throughout the year. How they choose to enrich their time is guided by their individual interests, though we encourage students to explore a variety of activities across different categories to gain a broader experience.

## Sport

Activities in the Sport category focus on physical activity and fitness. Be prepared to challenge yourself, improve your fitness, and develop new skills in a fun and active environment.

## Creative

Activities in the Creative category encourage you to express your imagination in a variety of ways. Whether through designing, acting, singing, painting, or other artistic pursuits.

## Cultural

Activities in the Cultural category help you develop your knowledge and skills across a range of areas, including history, film, and science.

## Employability

Activities in the Employability category provide valuable opportunities to build skills for your future and strengthen your CV, from DoFE to gaining first aid qualifications.

You will select a minimum of 4 activities for each enrichment block. The activities will cover all 4 categories.

## Activity Choices

All activities chosen will be considered when allocating; you must be prepared to participate in ALL your activity choices. Activities are not ranked when you select them.

# Sport

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## BARROW RAIDERS RUGBY

Get involved in our exciting Rugby League sessions and develop your skills with professional coaching from Barrow Raiders. Pupils will benefit from high-level training, learning teamwork, technique, and game play from experienced coaches. Football/rugby boots are a must.

## PADDLE SPORTS

Students will have the opportunity earn a British Canoeing; Discover Paddle Award through experiencing and developing their skills with a variety of water craft (e.g., Canoes, Kayaks, Paddleboards).

During the six-week enrichment block, students & school staff will be collected by Keppleway from school at 12:30 on a Wednesday and taken to an appropriate location for the afternoon's activity, before being returned to school by 16:00.

**Cost: Approx £75per student**

## DARTS

Are you the next Luke Littler? Take the Oche and lets find out! Whether you're a beginner or already a keen player, all abilities are catered for. It's not just about hitting the target, darts helps develop concentration, mental Maths, and strategic thinking.

## MTB CLUB

Get outdoors and explore the local area on your mountain bike while building confidence and skill. In this enrichment, you'll develop essential riding techniques, including balance and control at slow speeds, as well as tackling uphill climbs and downhill trails.

You'll also gain valuable knowledge on how to maintain and look after your bike, helping you ride safely and get the best performance from it.

Over the 6-week programme, you'll take part in exciting off-site rides, giving you the chance to put your skills into practice in real environments.

**Please note: Some weeks, students are not back on site until 4pm**

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## NETBALL

Want to take your netball to the next level? This enrichment is designed to help you improve your skills, boost your fitness, and grow in confidence on the court. Each session focuses on key attacking and defensive principles, developing your passing, movement, shooting, and overall game awareness. Suitable for all abilities, this is a supportive and enjoyable environment where you can challenge yourself, work as part of a team, and see real progress in your performance.

## FITNESS FOUNDATIONS

Looking to get more active and build confidence? This 6-week programme is the perfect place to start! Designed especially for beginners, each session introduces a different style of training – from Pilates and circuits to strength and HIIT. No experience needed, just bring your energy and willingness to try something new! You'll improve your fitness, learn new skills, and discover how good moving your body can feel.

## AUSSIE RULES

Get ready for non-stop action with Aussie Rules Football, one of the fastest and most dynamic sports around! Combining speed, skill, and physicality, this high-energy game keeps you constantly on the move.

In this enrichment, you'll develop key skills like powerful kicking, quick handballing, high catching, and rapid movement, all through fast-paced drills and exciting match play. Expect plenty of action as you build fitness, coordination, and teamwork in a fun, competitive environment.

# Sport

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## FOOTBALL

Whether you're new to football or already play competitively, this enrichment has something for everyone. With three pathways available, you can choose the level that suits you best:

- **Basic Level** – Ideal for students who don't play outside of school and want to build confidence, learn key skills, and enjoy the game in a supportive environment.
- **Advanced Level** – Designed for students who already play for a club or school team, focusing on developing technique, tactical understanding, and performance at a higher level.
- **Girls' Football (All Abilities)** – A welcoming and inclusive group for girls of all experience levels, offering the chance to build skills, confidence, and teamwork in a supportive and encouraging setting.

Across all groups, sessions will help you improve your passing, control, movement, and game awareness while staying active and having fun

## BASKETBALL

Ready to hit the court? This high-energy basketball enrichment is perfect for anyone who wants to improve their skills, fitness, and confidence. You'll develop key techniques such as dribbling, passing, shooting, and defending, all through fast-paced drills and exciting game play.

Each session focuses on teamwork, movement, and game awareness, helping you become a smarter and more effective player on the court.

Whether you're a beginner or already have experience, you'll be challenged to improve and have fun while doing it.

# Creative

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## WATERCOLOUR PAINTING

Discover the beauty of watercolour painting and develop your artistic skills in a relaxed, creative environment. In this enrichment, you'll learn a range of techniques from blending and layering to creating texture and detail, while exploring different themes each week.

## DOODLE CLUB

Take time to relax and express yourself through mindful drawing. In this enrichment, students will explore creative techniques such as doodling, Zentangles, and mandala art to create intricate patterns and colourful designs. You'll learn how repeating patterns and thoughtful colouring can help improve focus, reduce stress, and boost creativity. Each session offers a calm, supportive space to experiment with new ideas and develop your own unique artistic style.

## SCHOOL PRODUCTION - SET DESIGN

This activity introduces the basic elements of set design for the school production of Peter Pan, exploring its role and function within a production. You will explore approaches to design research and development, and be introduced to the tools required for the creation of the sets.

## ANIMATION WORKSHOP

The animation activity encourages you to explore formats and outcomes beyond traditional modes. you'll learn core creative skills in idea development, design, pre-production and production techniques all of which underpins the wide range of contemporary animation practices.

## VIDEOGAME MAGAZINE

Passionate about videogames? In this enrichment, students will take on the role of games journalists, creating a range of articles including reviews, previews, guides, and feature pieces. All work will come together to produce a professional-style videogame magazine.

This is a fantastic opportunity to develop writing, research, and creative skills while exploring the world of gaming from a new perspective. Please note: this enrichment focuses on writing about games – students will not be playing them.

# Creative

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## INTERACTIVE STORY WRITING

Step into the world of interactive storytelling, where you are in control of the narrative. In this enrichment, students will use specialist software to design and create branching stories where readers can make choices that shape the outcome.

You'll develop creativity, writing skills, and logical thinking as you plan different pathways, characters, and endings. Every decision matters, making each story unique and engaging.

## GARDENING

Students will have the opportunity to learn about the art of horticulture. Gardening is an all year round activity and each season brings with it different things to do and look after. Students will learn about pruning, sowing seeds, weeding, maintaining appropriate grounds to grow in and cultivating flowers and vegetables at the right times of the year. Each week we will attempt to make something useful to maintain the gardens or yards of students and school site.

## MAPPING MILLOM

Combine creativity with exploration in this exciting enrichment project inspired by illustrator Dave Draws. Students will begin by visiting Millom town to sketch, take notes, and collect key details about local landmarks and layout.

Using this research, you'll design and create your own unique illustrated map, bringing the town to life through colour, character, and creative interpretation.

Along the way, you'll develop observational drawing skills, learn how to communicate information visually, and experiment with illustration techniques.

## PRINTING & EMBOSSING

Explore the exciting world of textile design through hands-on printing techniques. In this enrichment, students will begin by using printing blocks to create embossed velvet, experimenting with texture and pattern. They will then design and carve their own printing blocks, using them to produce unique ink prints and beautifully embossed fabric pieces. This is a fantastic opportunity to develop creativity, craftsmanship, and an understanding of traditional printmaking methods while producing your own original designs.

# Creative

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## EXPERIMENTAL DRAWING

Step outside the ordinary and discover new ways of drawing in this creative enrichment. Students will explore a wide range of experimental techniques and approaches, from unconventional materials to imaginative styles and mark-making methods. This is a great opportunity to develop confidence, take creative risks, and see drawing in a completely new light while building a unique portfolio of work.

## UPCYCLING

Turn old into new in this creative and practical enrichment. Students will reuse and recycle household items or small pieces of furniture, transforming them into unique, refreshed pieces with a new purpose and even the potential to sell. Along the way, you'll learn valuable restoration skills, from preparation and repair to design and finishing techniques. This is a fantastic opportunity to develop creativity, craftsmanship, and an understanding of sustainable living.

## SEASONAL CRAFTS

Get creative throughout the year by making beautiful seasonal crafts. This enrichment focuses on themed projects inspired by autumn (including Halloween), Christmas, and Easter, giving you the chance to design and create decorations for every occasion. You'll make a variety of items such as candle holders, trinkets, wreaths, interior decorations, photo frames, and baubles, while developing a range of crafting skills and techniques.

## CROCHET & YARN CRAFTS

Looking for a calm, cosy, and creative way to unwind? Join Crochet & Yarn Crafts Club! In this welcoming enrichment, students will learn crochet skills step by step while creating a range of fun and handmade projects, including plushies, bookmarks, keyrings, and seasonal crafts.

Suitable for complete beginners as well as those with some experience, this club offers a supportive space to develop new skills, express creativity, and build confidence.

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## SCHOOL PRODUCTION - PETER PAN

Fly away to Neverland in next year's whole school production of Peter Pan! Whether you love acting, singing, performing or working creatively as part of a backstage supporting team, this is your chance to help bring a magical story to life on stage. You will rehearse scenes, develop characters, learn performance skills and work together towards a live production. There will also be opportunities to get involved with backstage roles, props, costume and creative ideas as the show develops. Perfect for students who enjoy drama, storytelling, teamwork and performance.

## RSC PERFORMANCE & SHAKESPEARE ENSEMBLE

Step into the rehearsal room and explore Shakespeare the way professional actors do with this Royal Shakespeare Company inspired enrichment! Through practical drama games, ensemble work and performance activities, students will discover how to bring Shakespeare's characters and stories to life in exciting and modern ways. No experience with Shakespeare is needed this club is all about building confidence, creativity and performance skills in a supportive environment. Perfect for students who enjoy acting, drama and creative challenges.

**Cost: £30**

## SCRAP BOOKING

Tell your story through creativity in this personalised scrapbook project. Students will design and create a scrapbook based on a theme or topic of their choice, such as a holiday, special event, or favourite place. Using a repurposed book from school or one brought from home, you'll transform it into a unique visual sketchbook filled with photos, drawings, keepsakes, and decorative elements. You can personalise your book with materials collected on trips, memorable items, or create a yearbook celebrating time with friends at school.

## CHRISTMAS CRAFTS

Do you love crafting? Do you love Christmas? If the answer is yes to both questions then come and have a go at Christmas crafts! We will learn how to make a range of festive products from paper craft (cards and crackers) to needlework, tree decorations, personalised snow globes and more! Instructions are provided for all activities so first-time crafters are welcome but you must come with patience and be willing to have a go!

# Creative

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## CHILDRENS STORYBOOK WRITING

Step into the world of children's storytelling in this creative and rewarding enrichment. Students will visit the library to explore a range of children's books, discovering what makes a story engaging and suitable for young readers aged 3–5. Over four weeks, you'll plan, write, and illustrate your own original story, developing your creativity, storytelling skills, and artistic style. The project will culminate in a special presentation at the library, where you'll have the opportunity to read your story to a small group of children and their parents, bringing your work to life for a real audience.

## SPA SCIENCE

Do you love cosmetics and body care products? Interested in how they're made or even considering a future in cosmetic science? This exciting enrichment is perfect for you! Over 6 weeks, you'll explore how to create your own facial and body products using everyday ingredients, while learning about the science behind popular items such as bath bombs, hair dyes, and skincare treatments. You'll also discover the fascinating world of aromatherapy and perfume, understanding how scents are created and used. Throughout the course, you'll make a range of products to take home, including lip balm, body oil, body scrub, face masks, and bath bombs.

## LEGO CLUB

Get creative and put your problem-solving skills to the test in this fun and hands-on enrichment! Each week, you'll take part in exciting LEGO challenges –working in teams to design, build, and test different structures. From creative free builds to fast-paced teamwork challenges, you'll develop communication, planning, and engineering skills in a supportive environment. With a new challenge every session, no two weeks are the same! Perfect for anyone who enjoys building, thinking creatively, and working as part of a team.

# Creative

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## DANCE THROUGH THE DECADES

Take a high-energy journey through the history of dance in this exciting 6-week enrichment! Each week, you'll explore iconic styles—from the Charleston and 50s Rock'n'Roll to disco, pop, hip hop, and street dance—learning the moves that defined each era. As the course progresses, you'll use your skills to create your own mash-up choreography, blending different styles into one unique routine. You'll then refine and rehearse your performance, building confidence and teamwork along the way. The programme finishes with an opportunity to perform or film your final piece—showcasing everything you've learned.

## DESIGN A BAND

Ever dreamed of creating your own band? In this exciting 6-week enrichment, students will design, develop, and bring a complete band concept to life. From choosing your genre and band image to composing original music using GarageBand, you'll step into the world of music production and branding. You'll create your band's identity, design logos and merchandise, plan a live concert, and develop promotional materials including posters and social media campaigns. Along the way, you'll build creativity, teamwork, and technical skills while shaping your own unique sound. The programme culminates in a final presentation, where you'll showcase your music, branding, and concert plans.

## SUMMER CONCERT

Be part of an exciting 6-week journey to create and perform in the schools summer concert. From rehearsing songs and designing promotional materials to organising the event and performing on stage, you'll develop musical, creative, and teamwork skills. The enrichment builds towards the summer concert, where you'll showcase your hard work and talent to an audience.

# Cultural

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## FILM CLUB

Film Club introduces students to the fundamentals of film making, exploring camera work, sound, editing, lighting and setting. Through analysis and creative tasks, students storyboard and design scenes while developing cultural awareness, empathy and critical thinking. The course builds confidence in interpreting films and empowers students to engage with cinema as a meaningful art form

## ANIMAL ENCOUNTERS

Are you the next David Attenborough? Join our exciting Animal Encounters sessions and experience up-close, hands-on learning with a variety of amazing animals. Each week focuses on a different group, giving pupils the chance to explore, handle, and learn about creatures from around the world. This unforgettable experience brings wildlife straight to you—perfect for curious minds and animal lovers alike.

**Cost: Approx £20-25 per student**

## CRIME SOLVING - YEARS 9-13 ONLY

Step into the role of a detective, open the sealed envelope, and work with your friends to uncover clues, piece together evidence, and solve the crime. Every detail matters—are you ready to spot what others might miss and become the next great investigator?

## SCIENCE CLUB

Students learn scientific theory through fun experiments, that where possible relate to real world applications. There is a focus on understanding complex theory in order to understand why a reaction or physical process works the way it does. In science club you will get to satisfy your science practicals cravings.

## PSYCHOLOGY - YEARS 9-13 ONLY

If you are interested in learning about the brain and behaviour, then you will enjoy psychology! Over the course of this enrichment we will cover theories and studies that try to explain why we do what we do, and act the way we act. We will look at explaining key events in history from a psychological perspective and can use these findings to predict future behavioural patterns.

# Cultural

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## DUNGEONS & DRAGONS

Students will be introduced to the world of D&D, building up through light experiences to creating their own characters for campaigns.

## WARHAMMER

Step into the exciting world of Warhammer, where creativity meets strategy. In this enrichment, students will build and paint their own detailed miniatures before bringing them to life in tactical tabletop battles.

Perfect for beginners and experienced hobbyists alike, you'll develop artistic skills, patience, and strategic thinking while immersing yourself in a rich fantasy universe.

Work on your designs, learn painting techniques, and challenge others.

## PODCASTING

Have something to say? In this enrichment, students will plan, create, and produce their own podcast on a topic they're passionate about. From developing ideas and writing scripts to recording and editing, you'll learn the skills needed to bring your voice to life. Whether you're interested in storytelling, current events, sport, or anything in between, this is your chance to be heard.

## TROPIC SKINCARE

Curious about how skincare really works? Students will explore the science behind the beauty industry while learning how to properly care for their skin. There will also be opportunities to sample Tropic products and learn firsthand about their benefits. Each student will receive a Tropic Skincare Starter Set to take home, helping you put your new knowledge into practice.

## WHO SHOT JFK? YEARS 9-13 ONLY

Step into one of history's greatest mysteries and uncover the truth behind the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. In this thought-provoking enrichment, you'll examine real evidence, explore different theories, and analyse key events surrounding that day in 1963. Working as a historian and investigator, you'll question sources, debate ideas, and build your own conclusions about what really happened. Was it a lone gunman, or is there more to the story?

# Cultural

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## ECOLOGY

Are you interested in the natural world? Would you like to learn more about wildlife around the world and right here on your doorstep? Ecology is for you! Each week you'll learn about different species, both local and international, and learn how to help protect them. Sessions will include classroom-based activities such as "virtual field trips" around the world and outdoor sessions onsite to study the natural world up close! Where possible, we may even have the opportunity to visit Miterdale Forest to support the "Nature Rich Miterdale" project. This session would include activities such as tree tube removal and guided walks.

## FIELD ECOLOGY

Are you interested in protecting the natural world? The Restore Hardknott Forest conservation project is for you! Each week you'll visit Hardknott Forest and contribute to the project's work to protect this beautiful landscape, including activities such as: tree planting, non-native tree removal, wildflower planting, trail camera monitoring, and just simply walking, enjoying time spent in nature.

## COOKING CLUB

Love cooking or want to build on the skills you've learned in Technology? This enrichment is the perfect opportunity to develop your confidence in the kitchen while creating a range of delicious dishes.

**Cost: Own ingredients required for 5 weeks of this enrichment.**

## READING FOR PLEASURE

Do you enjoy escaping into a great story? This enrichment is the perfect chance to relax, unwind, and immerse yourself in reading. Alongside reading, you'll also get the chance to design and make bookmarks, create eye-catching displays, and take part in activities that celebrate a love of books. We'll even visit Millom Community Library to explore everything it has to offer.

## STEM CLUB

Work alongside industry professionals from MNC to tackle a real-world design project in this exciting STEM enrichment. You'll explore problem-solving, creativity, and teamwork while developing practical skills in science, technology, engineering, and maths.

# DofE

The Duke of Edinburgh Award is the world's leading achievement award for young people. It encourages young people to take on challenges and live life as an adventure. Many employers and organisations, including colleges and universities, value the Duke of Edinburgh Award and believe that young people who undertake it are more confident, have better developed skills and can take on challenges.



The Award requires time, commitment and enthusiasm.

There are three elective sections:

Volunteering - Skills - Physical

These require students choose an activity & participate for one hour per week for each section over a period of 3-6 months.

There is also an overnight expedition to complete.

## BRONZE AWARD:

**Suitable for:** Students in years 9/10/12 in September 2026

**Requirements:** You will participate in the DofE for **2 blocks**.

Enrichment sessions will be used to support the completion of the elective sections and teach students the skills required for the expeditions section.

**Expedition(x2):** 2 day and 1 night (weekends)

**Cost:** £50 registration fee + Approx. £100 expedition fees

## SILVER AWARD:

**Suitable for:** Students in year 10/12 in September 2026, who have completed the Bronze Award

**Requirements:** You will participate in the DofE for **1 block**.

The expectations that the participant will show more independence than in Bronze Award

**Expedition(x2):** requirement is 3 day and 2 night. (weekends)

**Cost:** £60 registration fee + Approx. £120 expedition fees

## Provisional expedition dates

**Practice:** w/e 24th April, **Qualifier:** w/e 26th June

Students will be loaned group kit (tent/ cooking equipment), other items such as rucksacks & waterproofs are available if required (limited stocks)



# Employability

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## FIRST AID

Over this 6-week enrichment, students will learn essential first aid skills with Jules in a practical, hands-on environment. You'll gain the confidence to respond to real-life situations, including treating injuries, managing emergencies, and knowing what to do when someone needs help.

This course is perfect for anyone who wants to develop valuable life skills, build confidence, and make a real difference. By the end, you'll have a strong understanding of basic first aid and the confidence to take action when it matters most, alongside a basic first aid qualification.

**Cost: £36**

## SPORTS LEADERS - YEARS 9-13 ONLY

Are you passionate about sport and ready to take the lead? This 12-week programme will help you build confidence, improve communication, and develop coaching and leadership skills through practical activities.
