Course Description

Students will study:

- Coasts
- Earth's life support systems (carbon cycle/water cycle)
- Changing spaces – local, national and global
- Trade or migration
- Human rights or power
- Borders.

They will be required to debate TWO topics from the following:

- Climate change
- Disease dilemma
- Exploring oceans
- Future of food
- Hazardous earth.

Assessment

Paper 1

Written Exams (1¾ hours) - 24 % of A Level qualification - Physical Systems

Paper 2

Written Exams (1¾ hours) - 24% of A Level qualification • Human Interactions

Paper 3

Written Exam (2¾ hours) - 32% of A Level qualification • Geographical Debates

Coursework

Independent Investigation - 20% of A Level qualification

Two days Fieldwork will also need to be completed

Additional Entry Guidance

A grade 5 at GCSE is advisable to study Geography at A Level, but this is not a requirement.
