Course Description

The new Pearson Level 3 Alternative Academic Qualification BTEC National in Health and Social Care (Extended Certificate) allows students to engage in a broad investigation of various aspects of the health and social care sector.

The qualification is designed to be taken alongside A levels as part of a study programme and can link to learning in A level's such as Psychology, Biology or English. It is intended for students that wish to progress into higher education as a pathway to employment. Pearson has developed a Transferable Skills Framework to facilitate and guide the development of transferable skills through this qualification that includes skills such as taking personal responsibility; managing own learning; teamwork and problem solving.

<u>Extended Certificate</u> — this qualification provides a broad basis of study for the health and social care sector. It is the equivalent of 1 A Level. Mandatory units include Human Lifespan and Development, Human Biology and Health and Principles of Health and Social Care. Students also study one optional unit.

Assessment

Students are assessed through three mandatory and one optional unit.

- Two units will be assessed via a written examination.
- Two units will be assessed by internal written coursework via a Pearson Set Assignment Brief that will be externally moderated.
