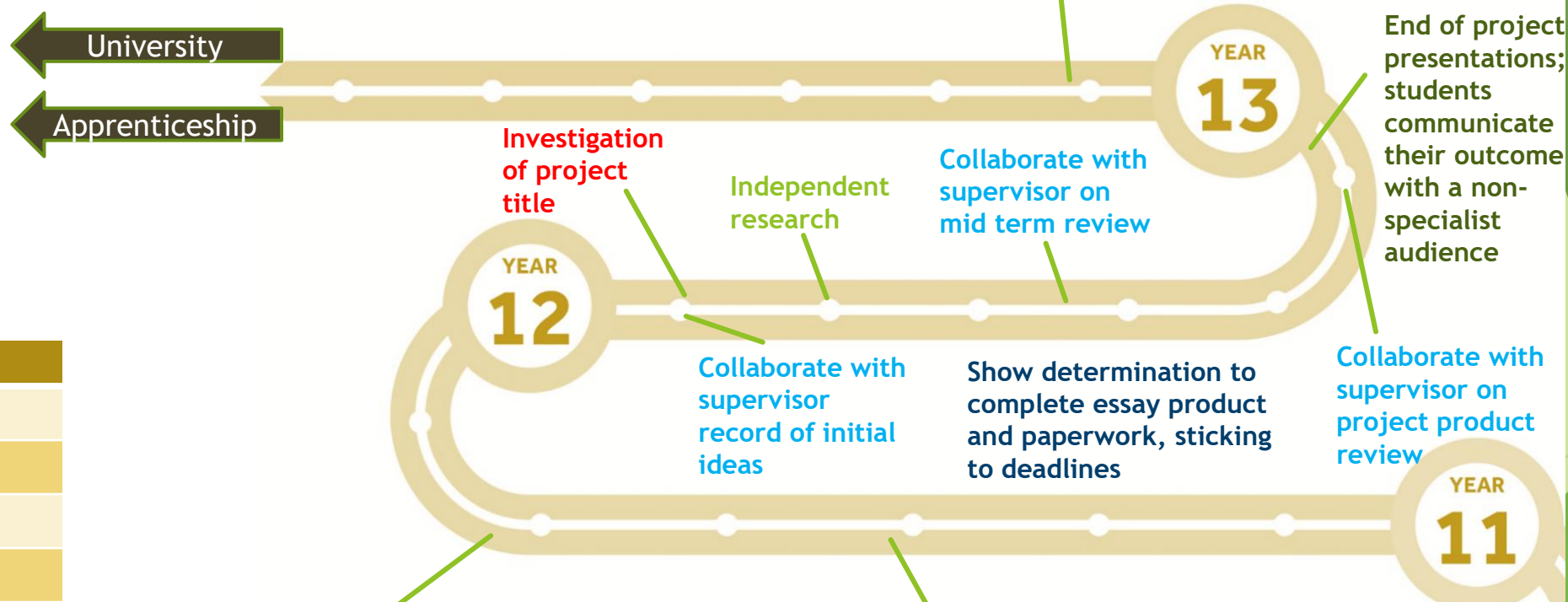


Millom School Learning Journey: EPQ
