At the weekend the Local Authority sent out advice that 12-30 year olds should go for a PCR test and we circulated that advice to you through social media. The link for this advice is <https://www.ncic.nhs.uk/news/everyone-between-12-and-30-urged-get-covid-test>

At the moment there are no definite plans to carry out any PCR testing at Millom School. This is because the LA are prioritising PCR testing in schools where there have been recent cases of Covid-19, or where rates in the community are higher. The LA are in discussions with schools about testing and should we be asked to carry out PCR testing in school then I will be in touch with you.

In the meantime I would urge that you follow the advice of the LA and get a PCR test for your child either at one of the test centres or by ordering one to arrive through the post. The instructions for this can be found via the link above.
