Dear Parent/Carer(s)

Following an increase in COVID-19 infections in Cumbria due to the Delta variant, the local authority and public health have advised that we adopt face coverings for students in communal areas from Friday 18 June 2021. We have had excellent support with this in the past and I would urge you to support this again. Those students who were exempt before will not be required to wear them as previously agreed.

To help prevent the virus spreading we are also encouraging all students to undertake twice weekly lateral flow testing at home. The results of these tests should be reported via [TestRegister.co.uk](https://www.testregister.co.uk) and on the NHS results page. If the test is positive, self-isolate and book a confirmatory PCR test. This can be done via [GOV.UK/get-coronavirus-test](https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test).

Both of these approaches are designed to keep everyone in school and in the wider community as safe as possible. This is a reminder of the importance of following the procedures we have in place in school such as the one way system and regular use of hand sanitizer.

Attached with this letter is a letter from Colin Cox, Director of Public Health, and a Covid quick guide from the local authority.
